Blanca de la Torre is an Independent curator and art critic. Before 2009, she curated exhibitions internationally in cities such as New York, Prague, London and Madrid. From 2009 to 2013, she acted as Chief Curator at ARTIUM, Basque Museum-Center of Contemporary Art (Vitoria-Gasteiz, Spain).

Between 2014 and 2015, She co-curated the exhibition trilogy *Invisible Violence*, which showed at MoCAB (Belgrade, Serbia), ARTIUM and Salzburger Kunstverein (Salzburg, Austria).

She recently curated exhibitions in New York at the Elisabeth Foundation Project Space and at Y Gallery (New York); in Mexico at Centro de las Artes, Monterrey, Museo Carrillo Gil, Mexico City; and Museo de Arte Contemporáneo de Oaxaca; in Colombia at NC-Arte, Bogotá and the group show PIGS, travelling to different European venues.

She is currently developing projects for museums like MUSAC in León, LAZNIA, Gdansk, Poland, or the South Florida Art Center in Miami, among others.
